Animal Sounds

Animals do not talk but they do communicate. Wolves hunt in packs. They communicate with barks and howls.

Male howler monkeys can make sounds that are heard far away. They make one of the loudest animal sounds in the world.

The rattlesnake warns enemies to stay away by shaking the rattle in its tail. Male frogs make sounds to attract female frogs.

Whales and dolphins communicate by making very high-pitched sounds that sound like singing. These can be heard in the water hundreds of miles away. Each dolphin has its own special sound.
